ABSTRACT

The results gotten from the data analysis showed that majority of the students of the Mountain Top University were negatively influences by the social media platforms, some saw the social media as a great source of information while majority saw it as a great form of distraction.

This project therefore recommends that various institutions should fully utilize the social media for their students' academic performances, and find tenable measures in order to improve the academic performances of their students.

2.3.1 Social Learning Theory:



Osharive(2015) examined the influence of Social Media and Academic Performance Of students in University of Lagos. Five Research questions and five Research hypotheses served as guides in this study. The descriptive survey method was adopted as the research design in order to achieve the goals of the study. The population of this study where 24,661 undergraduates of the University of Lagos. The simple random sampling technique served as a tool in selecting the sample of 378 students from the population of 24,661 undergraduates. A four-point Likert Type Rating Scale Questionnaire type, titled: social media and Academic Performance of Students Questionnaire (SMAAPOS) were used as instruments in the collection of data from the participants. The descriptive statistics of frequency counts and percentage, were used to analyze the demographic data while inferential statistics of Chi-square(x2) was used in testing the research hypotheses. Research findings showed that a great number of students in University of Lagos, are addicted to social media. To ensure this addiction is productive and not deprecating, the researcher recommended that social media should be majorly used for educational purposes; Social Networking Sites should be expanded and new pages should be created to enhance academic activities and avoid setbacks in the students' academic performance; and Students should be monitored and carefully watched by teachers and parents on how they use these sites This is to create a balance between social media and academic activities of students to avoid setbacks in the academic performance of the students.

Tayo, Adebola and Yahya (2019) performed a have a look at the Social Media Usage amongst Undergraduates and the Influences it has their academics. Further, undergraduates spend a mean of 2-three hours each day on social media, and their perceived functions of social media utilization encompass: socialization (83%), facts (74%), instructional (73%), business (68%), and entertainment (61%). The effects spotlight Internet dependency (45%), distraction (32%), anti-social behavior (6%), cyber bullying (four%), and writing and spelling abilities deficiency (24%) because the effects of social media on undergraduate studies. The have a look at concludes that the social media structures generally used are WhatsApp, Facebook, Instagram, and YouTube; which can be used specially for socialization, facts, and educational functions and might additionally possibly advocate the motive for dependency to social media.

Ogedebe, Emmanuel & Musa (2012) performed a have a look at on Facebook and Academic Performance in Nigeria Universities. CHAPTER THREE

Through them the researcher would be able ascertain both the negative and the positive influences of the social media on the undergraduate during the COVID-19 lockdown.

3.5 Research Instrument

The instrument used by the researcher during the course of the research is questionnaire. This instrument is known to give the respondents the freedom to express themselves. Through the use of this instrument, opinions are gotten and possible solutions are being considered or taken into account. The questions delivered to the respondents were being delivered in a close ended format and enough blank spaces provided for the respondent to express themselves through written words.

3.5.1 Validity and Reliability of Instruments

The supervisor received the instrument for further input and corrections. The first drafts of the charter are subject to visibility while the necessary corrections are made in the final draft all these must be done before an instrument could be confirmed to be valid. On the other hand, reliability of the instrument simply indicates the consistency of the instrument used by the researcher. The reliability of the instrument used by the researcher would be ensured through a pilot study which would be conducted on 20 mass communication students in the Mountain Top University.

3.6 Sampling Technique

During the course of this research the technique adopted by the researcher could be found under the probability sampling technique and this technique is called the Stratified Sampling Technique. The Stratified Sampling Technique is known to recreate the statistical features of population on a smaller scale thereby making research done by the researchers easy and credible, this technique is known to characterize the population in terms of gender, social class, religion, educational level etc. Through the use of this technique the researcher would be able to easily differentiate the negative impacts from the positive ones and also be able to ascertain the Functional and Dysfunctional Influence of Social Media Exposure to the Mountain Top Undergraduates. Through the use of this technique the researcher would also be able to categorize the gender, colleges, departments and levels of the Mountain Top Undergraduates who would be interviewed or questioned in order to ensure that the analysis done and results generated could be easily comprehended or understood.

Stratification also entails dividing the population into colleges (CHMS and CBAS). Then, the population of each college is derived by each department. From each department, sample is drawn randomly based on the proportion of the population in each department.

3.7 Determination of Sample Size

3.8 Method of Data Collection

The questionnaires were administered among the undergraduate students of the Mountain Top University (MTU). The respondents who answered the close ended questionnaires ranged from 100level students to 400level students of 2020/2021 undergraduate set in the university.

3.9 Method of Data Analysis

The analysis of data done by the research during the course of the research was done with the simple percentage method of data analysis. This took place after the questionnaires had been collected from the respondent. The data gotten from the questionnaires were presented in a tabular form where the numbers of respondent and corresponding percentage were inserted in that tabular form to ensure it is been read, understood and easily assimilated.

CHAPTER FIVE

5.0 SUMMARY, CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

5.1 Summary

This paper offers different perspectives on the topic "Perceive Functional and Dysfunctional Influence of Exposure to Social Media among Mountain Top University Students during the COVID-19 lockdown." This chapter is intended to summarize the research work, show conclusions derived from the research findings and give recommendations.

Background to the study explains social media as interactive digitally mediated technologies that facilitates the creation and sharing of information, interest, ideas and other forms of expression via virtual communities and networks. This medium of interaction called social media was introduced alongside platforms which play a very important role on the learning behavior of university students both positively and negatively and has had a great impact and influence on human lives in general.

The statement of problem explains discoveries in recent times that the use of the social media has done more harm than good. Some of the harms caused by the use of social media include cyber-bullying, decreased self-esteem which could later lead to depression, loss of focus, users forced to handle an intense amount of anxiety, creation of addiction.

The objectives of the study were outlined as follows:

 To ascertain the social media usage habits of undergraduate students of Mountain Top University during the COVID-19 lockdown; 2. To determine the dysfunctional influences of the social media on the academic performances of the undergraduate students of Mountain Top University;

3. To identify the social media platforms responsible for negative influences on the academic performances of the undergraduate students of Mountain Top University

4. To determine the functional influence of the social media usage on the academic performances of the undergraduate students of Mountain Top University;

5. To identify the social media platforms responsible for positive influences on the academic performances of the undergraduate students of Mountain Top University.

The conceptual review examined the concepts of social media in today's world, undergraduates, Mountain Top University, functional influences of social media, dysfunctional influences of social media, influences of exposure to social media, influence of covid-19 lockdown on undergraduates.

The theoretical framework of this chapter made use of the social learning theory that proposes that new behaviors could be easily acquired mainly through observation, learning and imitations of another person actions or behaviors and the New Media Theory which is applicable to the vitality of social media as emerging tool for news reportage and delivery of information.

The research methodology made appropriate use of the descriptive survey research design to achieve the objectives of this study, the area of study which is Mountain Top University with about 1,385 undergraduates as the population size, the stratified sampling technique was used to make statistical features of population on a smaller scale, the instrument used for this research is the questionnaire.

Chapter four gave the data presentation and analysis while explicitly elucidating the functional and dysfunctional influences of social media on the academic levels of each undergraduate that responded, the statistical analysis of the information obtained through the questionnaire was carried out in this chapter and the findings made from the data were discussed.

Chapter five summarized and concluded the research work with relevant recommendations.

5.2 Conclusion

Through the data made available by survey, it is clear that there is a significant link between the functional and dysfunctional influence of exposure to social media on Mountain Top undergraduates during the COVID-19 lockdown. The literature also shows that majority of undergraduates have these influences having some kind of effect on them and their all-round performances. There is a strong cord of media on the youth population of the undergraduate community which sometimes make the dysfunctional influences have more effect on them than the functional influences. In view of the result, the researcher is of the opinion that more efforts should be made to promote the values of social media functional influences to increase their all-round performance in their academics.

5.3 Recommendations

The findings in this study can be a practical tool which could prove useful to various institutions on how to fully utilize the social media for their students' academic performances, and what could be done in order to improve the academic performances of their students and avert any upcoming disaster in the educational sector in Nigeria. This study can guide the Mountain Top University management in knowing the impact of the social media on their students' academic performances. Through the results of these findings, it would assist other researcher who is carrying out a similar study in coming to a reasonable conclusion. This study will help analyze the attitude the students have towards social media. Finally, the results generated from this study will assist other private institutions with similar policies and visions in coming up with possible solutions that could lead to a drastic change and improvement in the academic performances of their students. Institutions also should assess their students at intervals to ascertain the involvement in the academic journey so as to know if they really are attentive and receptive.

5.4 Limitations of the study

When conducting this research, there were different challenges encountered which are time constraints that is the time which was meant for the studying and gathering of the data was not convenient for the researcher because of the situation of the academic activities going on currently in the institution, and questionnaires had to be sent and received at a later date and some were not returned or returned blank.

5.6 Contributions to Knowledge

At the end of the study, it is seen that social media mostly distracts undergraduates from their academic activities. The findings allow institution management sit up and find better and more scrupulous ways to pattern online/social media schooling/learning.

5.7 Suggestions for Further Research

Based on the suggested area for further study is the creation of awareness on social media and academics going hand-in-hand. Formats for online and distant learning can be further reviewed. Titles that can further be studied are:

a. Patterns of teaching by university lecturers during distant learning;

- b. Students' receptivity and attention whilst engaging in online schooling;
- **c.** Upside and downside of distant/online learning.
